The Core Problem for Edom: They are DECEIVED by their own PRIDE.

How is Pride Deceiving?

- Creates a belief in our own SELF-SUFFICIENCY. Obadiah 3, Psalm 10:4

Key Question: Where am I believing the lie that I am more competent and capable than God himself? What is the area I won't trust him with?

- We underestimate our FAULTS and BLIND SPOTS.
- Pride puts ourselves at the CENTER of everything.

Symptoms of Edom's Pride:

- Disengaged from the SUFFERING of others.
- Boasting over the MISFORTUNE of others.
- Using the adversity of others for self ADVANTAGE.
- OPPRESSIVE stance towards Judah.

God's Response to Edom's Pride:

Discipline: A gracious INTERVENTION of God in our lives to correct disobedience or a wrong disposition. Revelation 3:19

Truth: Discipline now or DISASTER later.

How Did God discipline Edom:

God removes their INFLUENCE.

God removes their means of being SELF-SUFFICIENT.

God removes their source of STRENGTH and PRIDE.

Discipline creates a climate in which humility and submission can be CULTIVATED.

Judgment: God's divine INTERVENTION to establish His will. God's judgment is a resounding no to injustice, evil and unrighteous and a yes to God's justice.

The Promise: God will establish his plan and his purpose.

Reflect:

- Where is PRIDE present in my life?
- Is God using someone or something as an INSTRUMENT of humility in my life?
- Where am I living in SELF-RELIANCE?
- Can I trust that God is strong COMPETENT and capable of directing my life?
- Who am I INVESTING in and giving away influence and leadership to?
