Jesus Revealed

The Church of Pergamum STOOD FAST in their faith even when Antipas was martyred.

Admonishment

The Church of Pergamum was DIVIDED by DECEPTIVE teaching.

Watch out for deception. REPENT of wrong ideas, practices & misplaced trust.

Jesus' eyes are like BLAZING fire & His feet are like BURNISHED bronze. Jesus has penetrating discernment & strength for executing judgement.

Admonishment

The church in Thyatira was DIVIDED by a lack of DISCERNMENT. Watch out for becoming tolerant of the intolerable.
