Abraham An Example of Trusting

Big Promises to Abraham Genesis 12:1-3

Great LAND

Great NATION

Great MESSIAH

Abraham Illustrates What Trusting Involves Genesis 12:4-9

- He LISTENED & WENT.
- He was fully INVESTED. He took all of his family & possessions.
- He went as a WORSHIPPER, calling on the name of the Lord.

Reality of Trusting

Trusting involves WAITING on God's TIMING. In the waiting Abraham was the recipient of a PROFOUND COVENANT.

- God made a SUZERAIN/VASSAL covenant with Abraham that He would bless Him with offspring as numerous as the stars & that his descendants would possess the land. Ultimately the line of Abraham would lead to Jesus who would BLESS all people.

Perspective

The big life will require TRUSTING God.

- Trust your mind to God's TRUTH.
- Trust your heart to God's GOODNESS.
- Trust your will to God's WAYS.

Principle

The DEEPER you trust in all three of these areas: mind, heart & will, the more grown up in your faith you will become.
