Big Question Traditions

When are traditions helpful and when are they hurtful? Mark 7:1-16

Hurtful

1. When man-made traditions are expected to be followed in a LEGALISTIC way.
2. When the tradition becomes ROUTINE and not heartfelt.
3. When the tradition CONFLICTS with or CHANGES the intention of God.

Helpful

A tradition can be helpful if it causes you to REMEMBER, RECEIVE, REJOICE or REDISCOVER truth about Jesus and relationship with Jesus.
