Moving from Remembrance to Receptivity

Traditions can be helpful when they enable us to <u>RECIEVE</u> the work God is doing in our lives.

Remembrance: <u>RECALLING</u> and <u>REFLECTING</u> on what God has done.

Receptivity: An <u>OPENNESS</u> to what God is doing and will continue to do in my life. -Receiving the work that God is doing requires a response of <u>OBEDIENCE</u>.

What We are Receiving: Isaiah 9:2 John 1:9-18

TRANSFORMATION: a new way of living and being by God's grace.

- -TRUTH a word God is speaking into your life.
- -TRAJECTORY a new path and direction for your life.
- -TRIAL a difficult place God is leading you through.

Roadblocks to Receptivity

- -FAMILIARITY
- -BUSYNESS
- -EXPECTATIONS
- -<u>UNAWARE</u>

Challenge: We have received something different than we expected or failed to receive what we hoped for.

RELEASE: anger, disappointment or wounding before we can be receptive.

Practices that Cultivate Receptivity: Proverbs 2:1-6

- -INTENTIONAL PURSUIT
- -REFLECTION
- -SILENCE AND LISTENING
- -WORD AND PRAYER

Engaging Traditions with Receptivity: When you do what you've <u>ALWAYS</u> done; slow down, think, reflect and pray asking: "God what would you have me <u>RECEIVE</u> anew and afresh in this practice?"
