How to Rebuild: Becoming a Movement

- I. God's PRIORITIES must become your PRIORITIES. Haggai 1:1-4

- II. Give CAREFUL thought to life. Be one who understands the ways of God.
Haggai 1:5-11
 - See the CAUSE & EFFECTS of decisions in life.

- III. God's people must be OBEDIENT. This makes them available to be STIRRED up by the Lord. Haggai 1:12-15a

- IV. Look PAST preconceived ideas & seek to SEE what God is up to. Haggai 2:1-9

Conclusion

God is often up to something way BEYOND what you see at the moment.
