- He is the Son of God. Matthew 3:16-17
- He is part of the Trinity. Matthew 3:16-17
- He put on flesh & became incarnate. II John 1:7
- He is fully God & fully man. John 1:14
- He was crucified for our sins. Mark 15:24
- He was resurrected from the dead. Matthew 28:1-7
- He is Savior for those who trust. John 3:15-18
- He sits at the right hand of the Father as our Advocate. I John 2:1

2017: Reasons to Believe

1. The empty tomb was discovered by women. In that culture, this was not the starting point of making a legend. Mark 16:1-8
2. The empty tomb's location was known, which allowed for verification of it being empty. This was a bad move if someone wanted to create a legend. Matthew 27:57-66
3. Those opposed to Jesus' resurrection did not deny the empty tomb but rather chose to discredit it with a false report. Matthew 28:11b-15
4. The realistic account of the disciples supports the resurrection's validity. John 20:24-29
5. The accuracy of the resurrection is reinforced by the short time period between its occurrence & written accounts about it.
6. There were many eye witnesses who saw the resurrected Jesus. I Corinthians 15:3-8
7. Many of the early disciples were willing to die as martyrs because they saw the resurrected Jesus.

2018 Easter: Big Question

What happens to a person when they DIE?

Big Thought

The dead do RISE! I Corinthians 15:12-23, 35-53

- I. Jesus was raised from the dead as the FIRSTFRUITS.
- II. The resurrection is the CORNERSTONE of the Christian faith.
