Reflection Question

David's Initial Success

1. David LANDED a job with the king. 1 Samuel 16:14-23
2. David DEFEATED the giant enemy named Goliath. 1 Samuel 17
3. David MARRIED Michal the daughter of King Saul. 1 Samuel 18

David Experienced Failure

1. David lost his JOB with the king. 1 Samuel 19
2. David became a man on the RUN and feigned insanity in the presence of his enemies to save his life. 1 Samuel 21:10-15
3. David lost his WIFE, Michal. 1 Samuel 25:44

Failure to Faith

David found STRENGTH in the Lord. 1 Samuel 30:6

Key Question

How did David find strength to move from failure to faith?

1. It began with a cave PRAYER. Psalm 142
 - A. David FACED his discouragement.
 - B. David sought the Lord as his only HOPE.

Reflection

The cave provides an opportunity to LEARN from failure to follow God.

2. David took ACTION. 1 Samuel 30:7-8
 - In any area where you are concerned about failing, doing nothing will ASSURE it!
 - Part of moving from failure to faith involves the WILLINGNESS on your part to take God-anointed action.

Conclusion: From Failure to Faith

Continue to RUN the RACE God has called you to run. Hebrews 12:1-3
