Reflection Thought

We are often focused on “WHAT should I do?” whereas Jesus is focused on “HOW you should do life.” I Corinthians 10:31

- The right direction is to do all things for the GLORY of God. I Corinthians 10:31

2. Be careful not to make life-direction setting decisions in REACTION to hardships, criticism & dry seasons. II Corinthians 10-12
3. How will the proposed direction or change that you are considering in your life use your ABILITIES & spiritual GIFTS? I Corinthians 12, Romans 12:3-8

Reflection Statement

It is bad STEWARDSHIP to spend your life in a position that needs somebody else’s talents.

4. How does this direction or decision affect the KINGDOM of God? Philipians 2:3-4
5. Honestly consider your MOTIVES. Psalm 139:23-24
 - A. Ask the Lord to SEARCH your heart & REVEAL to you any offensive ways.
 - B. Seek the Lord’s GUIDANCE for your future. Ask Him to lead in the way everlasting.

6. SEEK out godly counselors & LISTEN to them. Proverbs 15:22

Conclusion

What do you do if you still don’t know what to do? Proverbs 16:9

Make plans that take into consideration the above points & count on the Lord to DIRECT.
